Our Story

In November of 1998, after much prayer + a candid conversation in our kitchen, I founded High Praises Church alongside my wife, LaDonna, with just 18 people + a clear, God-given vision. From the beginning, our heart was to create a place of worship where everyone was welcome—no matter their background, appearance, or story—because God's presence brings people together, not apart.

Early on, a simple phrase became our foundation: Keep the Main Thing the Main Thing — the Main Thing is the love of Jesus Christ.

What began in the basement grew through several seasons + locations, each marked by faith, sacrifice, + obedience. In August of 2021, God led us into our current location, where we continue to serve the East Tennessee region + reach people locally + globally through future campuses + our online campus—teaching people to dream big because we serve a big God.

LaDonna + I shared 27 beautiful years of marriage. On June 4, 2016, she went to Heaven, leaving a legacy of love that continues to shape our family + church.

Today, I am grateful for the new chapter God has written alongside my wife, Heather, as we lead High Praises Church together with our blended family of 10 with unity, vision, + a continued passion to love people well.

From 18 people in 1998 to all that God is still building today, our story remains the same: keeping the Main Thing the Main Thing + letting the love of Jesus change lives.



Our Beliefs

We believe that God is Love according to 1 John 4:16, and that we, as His children, should make it our goal to walk His love out in our everyday life. A personal relationship with Jesus is at the forefront of what is taught at High Praises Church. Constitution + *By-Laws*

NAME

The church shall be known as High Praises Church.

PURPOSE

The purpose of High Praises Church is to carry out the great commission of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, to provide a loving and happy environment for a hopeless world, and encourage everyone to receive His Spirit as his or her source of personal strength.

INCORPORATION

The church is incorporated according to the laws of the State of Tennessee.

DOCTRINE

The church shall believe in the whole Bible rightly divided as the infallible and inspired word of God. The Bible shall be the basis for all doctrine of the church. We believe that our salvation is acquired and retained by Jesus Christ and that the Holy Spirit will guide us into all truth.

GOVERNMENT

The Pastor and the Elders will conduct all church business as follows: There will be three votes cast on any given matter. The Pastor has one vote. The Senior Elder has one vote and the Junior Elder has one vote, which represents the vote of the remaining elders.

JOINING PROCESS

If a person desires to be a member of High Praises Church, he or she must make his or her desire known to the Pastor. At that time, they become a prospective member. A prospective member will become an accepted member of the church upon completion of a Join the Journey Experience.

DUTIES OF CHURCH MEMBERS

A member of High Praises Church is expected to live a life that is in complete accordance with the doctrine of the church and aligned with the word of God to reflect a Christ-centered life. A church member is expected to promote unity and must be willing to stop any conversation that tears down the vision of the church. A church member should support the church in prayer, regular church attendance and service. A church member will also be expected to tithe.

CONDUCT

All church members will be expected to conduct their lives according to the principles of the Bible and in accordance with the by-laws of High Praises Church.

TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership will be terminated upon the death of a member or if the member requests that their name be removed from the church membership list. If someone does not attend any services in six months, his or her name could be removed from the church membership list. If any member is found doing anything to tear down the vision of the church, or found in an act that is not in line with the Bible or church constitution, their name could be removed from the church membership list. The Pastor and Elders of the church will make any decisions concerning termination and membership.

ADMINISTRATION

The gift of administration is the divine strength or ability to organize multiple tasks and groups of people to accomplish these tasks.

DISCERNMENT

WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

The gift of knowledge is the divine strength or ability to bring truth to a situation by supernatural revelation. This is often accompanied by a word from God.

Acts 5:1-11; 1 Corinthians 12:8; Colossians 2:2-3

LEADERSHIP

The gift of leadership is the divine strength or ability to influence people at their level while directing and focusing them on the big picture, vision, or idea.

Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 3:1-13, 5:17; Hebrews 13:17

MERCY

The gift of mercy is the divine strength or ability to feel empathy and to care for those who are hurting in any way.

Matthew 9:35-36; Mark 9:41; Romans 12:8; 1 Thess. 5:14

MIRACLES

The gift of miracles is the divine strength or ability to alter the natural outcomes of life in a supernatural way through prayer, faith, and divine direction.

Acts 9:36-42, 19:11-12, 20:7-12; Romans 15:18-19; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28

PASTOR/SHEPHERD

The gift of pastor/shepherd is the divine strength or ability to care for the personal needs of others by nurturing and mending life issues.

John 10:1-18; Ephesians 4:11-14; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-3

PROPHECY

The gift of prophecy is the divine strength or ability to communicate God's truth and heart in a way that calls people to a right relationship with God.

Acts 2:37-40, 7:51-53, 26:24-29; 1 Corinthians 14:1-4; 1 Thessalonians 1:5

SERVICE

The gift of serving is the divine strength or ability to do small or great tasks in working for the overall good of the body of Christ.

Acts 6:1-7; Romans 12:7; Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 1:16-18; Titus 3:14

TEACHING

The gift of teaching is the divine strength or ability to study and learn from the Scriptures primarily to bring understanding and depth to other Christians.

Acts 18:24-28, 20:20-21; 1 Corinthians 12:28; Ephesians 4:11-14

TONGUES (+ INTERPRETATION)

The gift of tongues is the divine strength or ability to pray in a heavenly language to encourage your spirit and to commune with God. The gift of tongues is often accompanied by interpretation and should be used appropriately.

Acts 2:1-13; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 14:1-14

WORD OF WISDOM

The gift of wisdom is the divine strength or ability to understand and to bring clarity to situations and circumstances often through applying the truths of Scripture in a practical way.

Acts 6:3,10; 1 Corinthians 2:6-13, 12:8
